Autumn planting of sugarcane is done in the month of October. For good yields, planting should be completed up to 20th October. Delay in planting may cause a reduction in yield as germination of sugarcane is reduced due to low temperature in late planting. Spring cane is planted in February-March.

How to Grow Sugar Cane in Your Yard: Getting it Started ...

Sugar cane can only be planted on grass, dirt, podzol, and sand blocks. The block must be directly adjacent to water and not merely above or diagonal as with crops. If a plant's water source is removed, it will break when it is next updated. In Bedrock Edition, the sugar cane is updated with its water, so it breaks immediately.

A sugar cane plant looks similar to bamboo. It has a stiff stalk that grows typically between 10-13 feet (3-4 m) in height and with a diameter of about 2 inches (5 cm). Some species can even reach 20 feet (6 m) or more in height. The stalk is composed of segments called joints.

Sugar cane must be planted on a grass block, dirt, coarse dirt, podzol, sand, or red sand that is directly adjacent to water, waterlogged block, or frosted ice (not merely above or diagonal to water), or on top of another sugar cane block.

Sugarcane plant fields are replanted every two to four years. After the first year's harvest, the second round of stalks, called a ratoon, begins to grow from the old. After each harvest of the sugarcane, the field is burned off until such time as production levels decline.
